Curriculum

Science: Children will be investigating simple machines as part of our science curriculum. Children will have opportunities to build and experiment with pulleys, levers, wheels and axels. These devices were used in castles and are still all around us in the modern world. We will also explore simple chemical reactions when we try making potions later in the month.

Art: Children will be creating many of the things we associate with kings, queens, castles and fairvtales. From crowns to magic wands, stained glass windows to brick castle walls, we will use a variety of materials and methods for making our own indoor castle and accessories. As we read about fairies and dragons, we'll move into the realm of fantasy to create dragons, unicorns and pixies. Children will use their imaginations and creative talents to bring their own fantasies to life.

Dramatic Play: Children will be transforming the block area into a castle. The children will be dressing up as knights, kings, queens, princes and princesses. Throughout the month these roles may change to more fantasy play; exploring unicorns and fairies. The large blocks will be available to create castles and draw bridges, as well as other aspects the kids decide to explore.

Literacy/Social-Emotional: We will be reading books about knights, princesses and castles. Mid-way through we will add in dragons, unicorns and fairies! We will be comparing similar stories by different authors, creating puppets shows and reenacting stories. The month will end with kids writing and drawing their own fairytales.

Everyone will have opportunities to get their fingers on the keys and explore melody using various instruments. We love the cajon (Cuban box drum), made for us by Maeve Dunn's grandfather. It's
